Intentional sequencing of rich thematic units creates learning experiences that are relevant to learners' interests and appropriate to checkpoint proficiency targets. Vertical articulation spirals proficiency development and recycles and reinforces thing quency vocabulary and grammatical structures. In this session, participants will examine templates to help analyze and sequematic units across the checkpoints. Presenters will also demotes tracels that can be used to assess how well the curriculum addresses the revised NYS Learning Standards for World Languages, their embedded language functions, and NYS World Language themes and topics.
